

BYLAW NO. 1-97

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH APPEAL FEES  
(SUBSECTION 303(7), (8) Rural Municipalities Act, 1989)

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pleasantdale No. 398, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Bylaw is to enable the Council to establish fees for the purpose of assessment appeals.

2. Every person who makes an appeal against their property, in whole or in part, shall pay an amount established by this Bylaw to be \$100.00.
3. Where an appellant is successful in whole or in part, on an assessment appeal at either the board of revision or the appeal board, the fee is refunded.
4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of final passing.
