BYLAW NO. 1-97

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH APPEAL FEES (SUBSECTION 303(7), (8) Rural Municipalities Act, 1989)

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pleasantdale No. 398, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. PURPOSE
 - The purpose of this Bylaw is to enable the Council to establish fees for the purpose of assessment appeals.
- Every person who makes an appeal against their property, in whole or in part, shall pay an amount established by this Bylaw to be \$100.00.
- 3. Where an appellant is successful in whole or in part, on an assessment appeal at either the board of revision or the appeal board, the fee is refunded.
- 4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of final passing.
