### **Purpose**

To provide guidance to administration, staff and the public regarding good husbandry practices in regards to Municipal Infrastructure within the Municipality.

### **Municipal Infrastructure**

Municipal Infrastructure means the road bed and road area, municipal right-of-ways (ditches), culvert and bridges, streets associated drainage and utility right-of-way.

1. Roads provide a means of transportation through the municipality
2. Bridges, culvert and ditches provide a means of water drainage as directed by WSA or the Municipality
3. Utilities right-of-ways provide water, power, energy and telephone

The purpose of this policy is to provide an environment where the traveling public and ratepayers can travel safely within the municipality.

### **Infraction**

Any infraction reported to the municipal office by a complainant it shall be understood to have been filed against the municipality; should the municipality be negligent in regards to this bylaw they will be responsible to rectify the problem.

Should the infraction be caused by a ratepayer the municipality will contract a third party to facilitate the work following which the municipality will invoice the landowner for the cost of the work.
