Purpose

To provide guidance to administration, staff and the public regarding good husbandry practices in regards to Municipal Infrastructure within the Municipality.

Municipal Infrastructure

Municipal Infrastructure means the road bed and road area, municipal right-of-ways (ditches), culvert and bridges, streets associated drainage and utility right-of-way.

- 1. Roads provide a means of transportation through the municipality
- 2. Bridges, culvert and ditches provide a means of water drainage as directed by WSA or the Municipality
- 3. Utilities right-of-ways provide water, power, energy and telephone

The purpose of this policy is to provide an environment where the traveling public and ratepayers can travel safely within the municipality.

Infraction

Any infraction reported to the municipal office by a complainant it shall be understood to have been filed against the municipality; should the municipality be negligent in regards to this bylaw they will be responsible to rectify the problem.

Should the infraction be caused by a ratepayer the municipality will contract a third party to facilitate the work following which the municipality will invoice the landowner for the cost of the work.
