

A BYLAW CONCERNING THE ERECTION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SIGNS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pleasantdale No. 398 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw the expression "road" means any public highway within the municipality as defined in The Highway Act, other than a Provincial Highway as designated pursuant to such Act.

2. Yield signs shall be erected at the intersections of roadways at the following locations:

<u>LOCATION OF INTERSECTION</u>	<u>SIDE OF ROAD</u>	<u>DIRECTION FROM INTERSECTION</u>	<u>FACING TRAFFIC FROM</u>
1. SW-2-40-18-W2	West	North	North
2. NE-11-41-18-W2	East	South	South
3. SW-30-42-17-W2	East	South	South
4. SE-28-42-16-W2	West	North	North
5. NW-22-42-16-W2	East	South	South

3. All signs erected pursuant to Section 2 hereof shall be erected not less than three metres and not more than fifteen metres from the near edge of the intersected roadway.

4. The Provisions of The Vehicles Act shall apply, wherever applicable, to every sign erected pursuant to Section 2.

5. No person shall alter, damage, remove, deface, knock down or tamper with any sign erected pursuant to this Bylaw.

6. Any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
