- 3. That this Bylaw 11-2022 be repealed and Bylaw 01 2023 will come into force on March 29, 2023.

- It is understood and agreed that this agreement shall commence on the date of passing. This agreement may be terminated by any one party to the agreement by giving 60 days' notice in writing to all parties involved.


