BYLAW NO. 01 - 2023

**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PLEASANTDALE NO. 398 TO
PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT RESPECTING THE FUNDING
ASSISTANCE OF THE NAICAM FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICES**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pleasantdale No. 398 on the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Pleasantdale No. 398 is hereby authorized to enter into the agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, and identified as Exhibit A, with the following:
 - a. Town of Naicam; and
 - b. R.M. of Spalding No. 368; and
 - c. R.M. of St. Peter No 369; and
 - d. R.M. of Lake Lenore No. 399; and
 - e. Village of Spalding; and
 - f. Village of Pleasantdale

for the purpose of providing funding assistance for the Naicam Fire and Rescue Services.

2. The Reeve and Administrator of the Rural Municipality of Pleasantdale are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreement identified as Exhibit A.
3. That Bylaw 08-2022 be repealed and Bylaw 01 – 2023 will come into force on March 29, 2023.

Memorandum of Agreement made this 01 day of January, 2023

Between:

R.M. of Spalding No. 368; and
R.M. of St. Peter No. 369; and
R.M. of Pleasantdale No.398; and
R.M. of Lake Lenore No. 399; and
Village of Spalding; and
Village of Pleasantdale; and
Town of Naicam

This agreement is as follows:

1. The areas covered by the Naicam Fire and Rescue Service in the above listed Municipalities are as per attached maps supplied by the Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency and hereto attached as Schedule A and forming a part of this agreement.
2. Fees charged for responding to fire and rescue calls within said area shall be as listed in Schedule B hereto attached and forming a part of this agreement.
3. The parties to this agreement agree to jointly provide funding assistance to the Naicam Fire and Rescue Services for the operation and maintenance that is not covered by fees charged for responding.
4. Funding amounts for each party are list in Schedule C hereto attached and forming a part of this Agreement.
5. The parties agree to meet annually to review expenditures and adjust funding accordingly
6. The parties agree that any amount with respect to a service provided pursuant to this agreement to a person that remains unpaid after 60 days or the end of the year in which the service was provided, whichever comes first, shall pay to the Town of Naicam the amount charged, with exception of fire calls to burning vehicles on public highways within the boundaries of the municipality. This amount may then be added to and form part of the taxes on any land or improvement owned by the person as provided for in Section 42(3) of *The Municipalities Act*.
7. It is understood and agreed that this agreement shall commence on the date of passing. This agreement may be terminated by any one party to the agreement by giving 60 days' notice in writing to all parties involved.
8. If a municipality within the Naicam fire service area does not participate in the operation and maintenance portion of the agreement, the property owner will be charged in the amount of two (2) times the fees. It is suggested that the municipality in question notifies their rate payers to adjust their coverage accordingly.

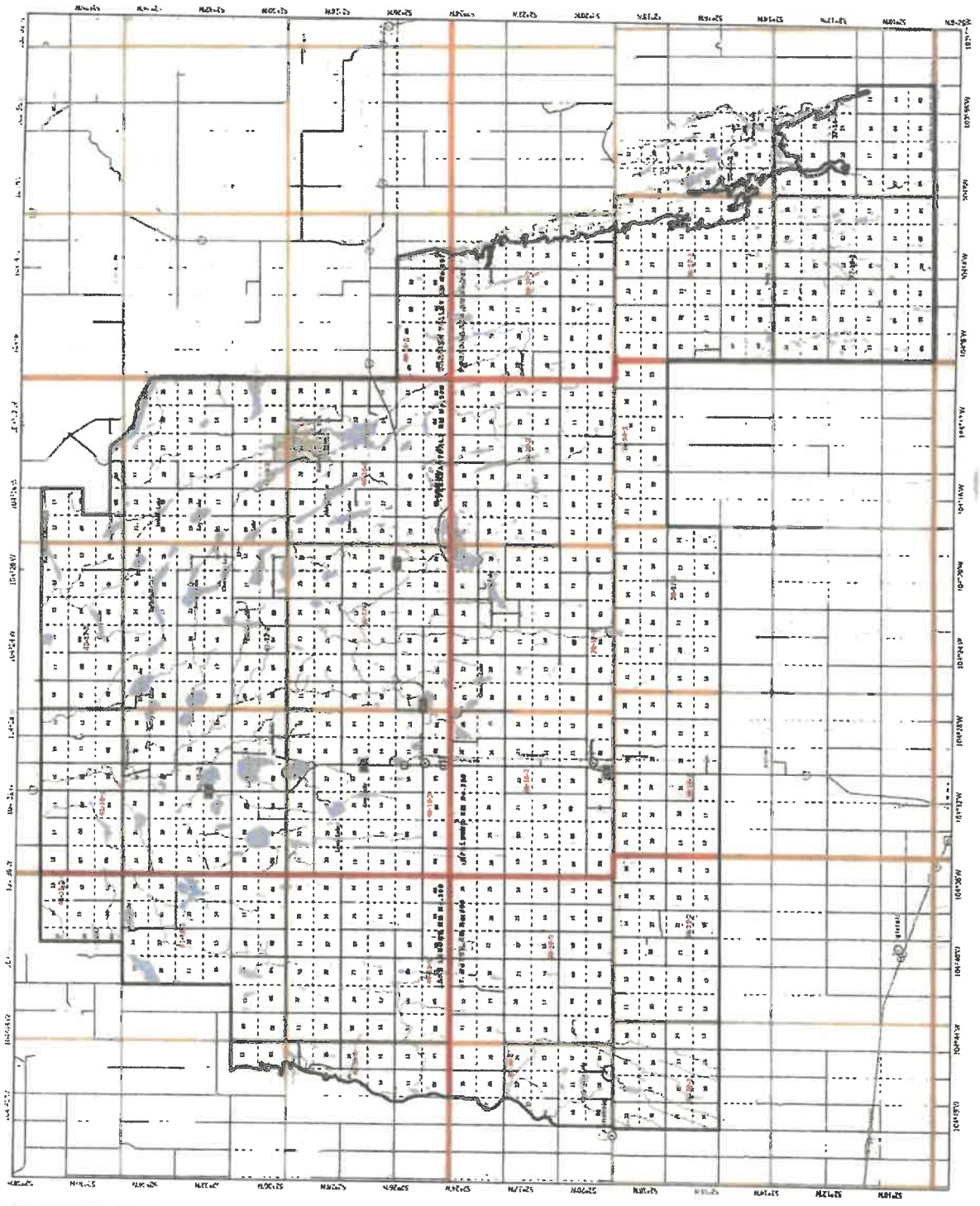
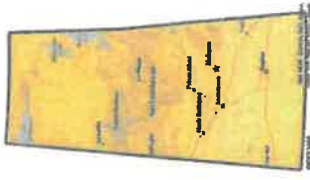

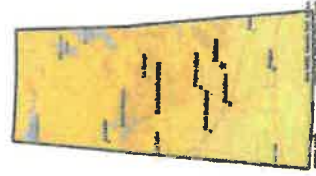


Naicam Fire District Saskatchewan

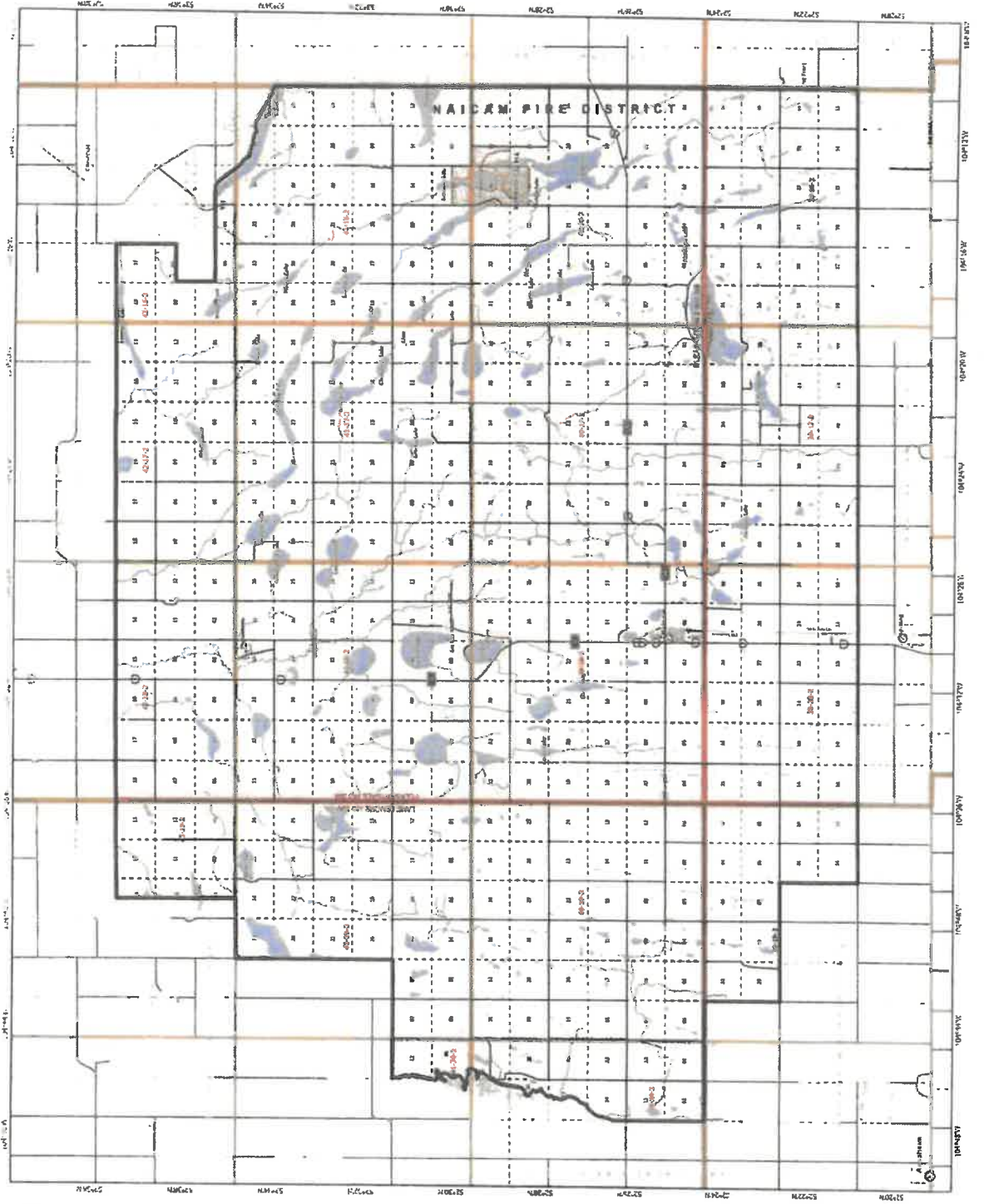
