

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF ABSORPTION FIELDS OR ABOVE-GROUND FILTERS
IN THE HAMLET OF LAC VERT.

Under the provisions of Section 83 and 73 (r) of The Public Health Act.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pleasantdale No. 398, in the
Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Hereafter no absorption fields or above-ground filters intended as
private sewage works and used for the purpose of sewage disposal, shall be
constructed within the Hamlet of Lac Vert.

2. This Bylaw does not apply with respect to absorption fields or
above-ground filters constructed prior to the passing of this Bylaw.

3. Hereafter, sewage holding tanks conforming to CSA standards, shall be
used as private sewage works systems in the Hamlet of Lac Vert.

4. Sewage holding tanks, shall have a capacity of at least 1000 gallons
and be sufficiently large to accomodate at least 15 days' sewage from the premises
and of a design acceptable to the council of the municipality.

5. All existing absorption fields or above-ground filters, which are
used as private sewage works, and are found to leak surface accumulation of
sewage, shall be withdrawn from service immediately and replaced in accordance
with Section 3 of this Bylaw or repaired to the satisfaction of the council of
the municipality.

6. Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this Bylaw
shall be liable to the penalties provided in The General Penalty Bylaw of the
municipality.
