RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PLEASANTDALE NO. 398

BYLAW NO. 12 - 2022

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR RURAL CIVIC ADDRESSING

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pleasantdale No. 398 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- Civic Number Installation shall be attached to a galvanized steel post planted a minimum
 of three (3) feet into the ground and shall be located near the point of access of the
 principal building. It shall not be obstructed from view and shall be visible when viewed
 from the closet place on the travelled portion of the municipal road.
- 2. Rural Civic Addressing signage shall be doubled-sided and posted perpendicular to the municipal road which provides access to the principal building or land.
- 3. The owner of the property shall maintain the civic addressing sign in good order.
- 4. The Administrator or designate shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this bylaw.
